



BETTY BANGHART MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP
INFORMATION

The Deer Creek Chorale Scholarship was created to encourage and support students who desire to sing as a member of this exciting community choir. There are three levels of awards; each providing different support.

| <u>Award</u> | <u>Level of Support</u> | <u>Value</u> <i>(approximate)</i> |
|--------------|---|--------------------------------------|
| Gold | Covers the cost of membership and music | \$150 |
| Silver | Covers the cost of membership | \$110 |
| Bronze | Covers the cost of music | \$40 |

Requirements – The scholarship is for a full season; fall through spring. Applicants must be formally participating full or part-time in schooling (public, private, or home) and at least 15, but not more than 22 years of age on the date of the first rehearsal. They must have an endorsement from a music teacher/choir director that can credibly describe their musicianship and capacity for participation in the chorale.

Expectations – Recipients of the Deer Creek Chorale Scholarships will be expected to participate fully as a member of the choir for the season; meeting or surpassing the DCC standards for attendance, participation, and performance. It is also expected that recipients will be good ambassadors of the chorale by sharing and promoting its vision and mission with family, friends, and others.

Procedure – Interested students that meet the requirements as described should download or otherwise obtain the official Scholarship Application and provide all of the requested information in addition to 1) a brief letter/essay describing the applicant’s qualification for the scholarships, and 2) a letter from one of the applicant’s references endorsing the applicant’s musical capacity. The application must be submitted and received **no later than September 1, 2016.** Mail it to the attention of Wayne Perry, Assistant Music Director, at the address below.

Applications will be reviewed by the Scholarship Committee and announcements of the recipients will be made prior to the first rehearsal of the season, Tuesday, September 13, 2016.
